

CHURCH PLANTERS SCHOOL

Curriculum Development for Church Planters Training

The target group for this training is for rural churches who have elders or deacons who are involved in Church planting but have had little or no biblical training. This is not to say that others will not benefit from the programme. It is also aimed at those who cannot afford formal Bible School training or do not have the necessary entrance requirements for colleges.

The basics that need to be taught:

- 1. Skills
- 2. Content (See Curriculum below)

SKILLS

Language and communication skills

- Reading
- Comprehension (includes interpretation of Scripture)
- Research (finding information)
- Writing
- Speaking (Includes preaching)
- Listening
- Memorisation
- Comparison

Develop preaching and teaching skills along the way.

Start with 2-3 minute presentations i.e. give an explanation; story telling; demonstrations, illustrations. Based on course material - each student may be given a different skill to be evaluated on.

Life skills

- Planning
- Research (information search)
- Brain storming (collecting ideas from a group)
- Decision making
- Implementation
- Evaluation
- Observation
- Recording information
- Interpreting information
- Map reading

Preaching

Develop preaching and teaching skills along the way.

Give opportunities for 2-3 presentations on topics discussed. Each one can be given a different aspect to focus on e.g. Give an explanation, present a challenge, tell a story, give a suitable illustration, etc.

In actual preaching teach the difference between topical preaching and exposition.

Good to take a specific book and preach through it.

Important for Old Testament (Rom.15:4) - Be careful to not over spiritualise the Old Testament.

COURSE TIME TABLE

- Best if all students can be accommodated on site for convenience and punctuality.
- The course will be 11 weeks, one week per month running from January to November. Other alternatives can be considered to suit circumstances of learners.
- A week will run from Monday to Friday. The day's programme will be as follows:

08:00 - 09:00 Devotions and Prayer
```

09:05 – 11:00 Two sessions with a short break in between.

11:00 - 11:20 Tea

11:20 - 13:00 Two sessions a short break in between

13:00 - 14:00 Lunch

14:00 - 15:00 One session

- Rest of the day can be divided up into finishing assignments and practical work.
- Approximately 4.5 hrs per day. Total course will be 4.5 x 5 x 11 = 247.5 hrs.

TRAINERS

A train the trainer programme will be run. The concept is that each major region will have trainers and a sponsoring church where training can be held. Local pastors who have a passion for church planting can be recruited.
